In order To survive and thrive during and post Covid-19, companies need to reassess their digital infrastructure now.

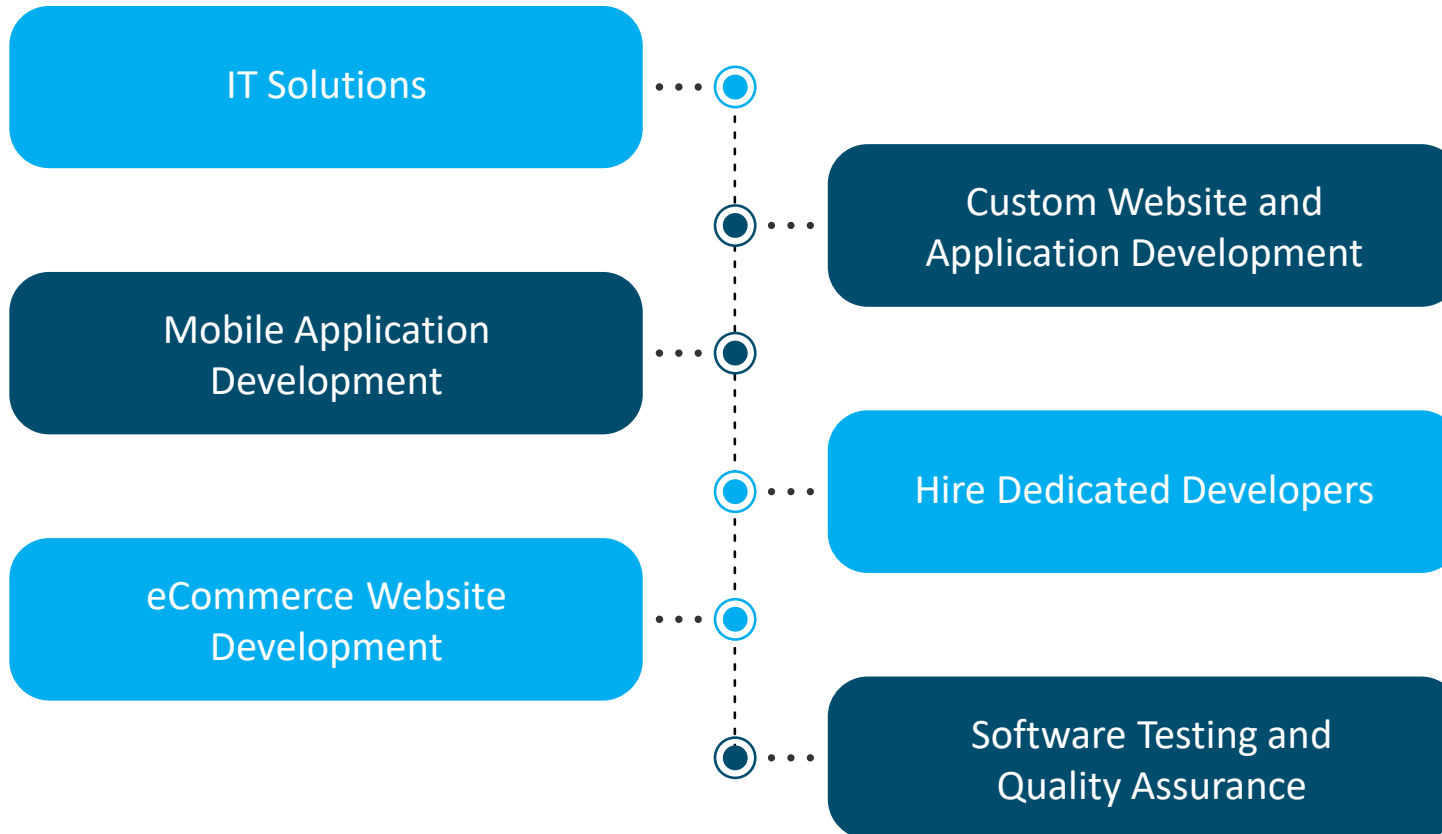
